Kate Barron (*Office Pudney*) After a 7-year theater hiatus, Kate is excited to return to the stage as Officer Pudney! Favorite past roles include Nora Morton (*Brighton Beach Memoirs*) and Elma Duckworth (*Bus Stop*). Offstage, Kate works as a librarian at Stanford University. Special thanks to Emily, Greet and Coastal Repertory Theatre for this opportunity!

Mark Drumm (Ernie Cusack) Mark is happy to be back at CRT after too many years. On the CRT stage, Mark has been seen in Awake and Sing, A Christmas Story, 12 Angry Men, and The Full Monty. Mark has also directed several shows at CRT: Lend Me a Tenor, It's a Wonderful Life Radio Play, Sylvia, Tomfoolery and Noises Off, to name a few. In the real world, Mark is a middle school teacher in San Mateo.

Lisa Guevara (Cookie Cusack) Lisa Burton Guevara is thrilled to be back at Coastal Rep where she was last seen as Harper in Angels in America: Millennium Approaches. Other recent credits include The Tempest and Fresh Produce at The Pear Theatre, Shoggoths on the Veldt, Anne of the Thousand Days and The Charitable Sisterhood at Dragon Theatre and a prior production of Rumors at Santa Clara Players. Deborah Joves (*Chris Gorman*) This is Deborah's 18th production with Coastal Rep, so she is now officially legal. In real life, Deborah can be as high strung as her character, although she doesn't smoke. We can neither confirm nor deny her ability to either hold or not hold her liquor. Deborah has worked throughout the Bay Area, including with Half Moon Bay Shakes, Pacifica Spindrift Players, Crystal Springs Theatre, New Fillmore Theatre Company, the SF Fringe Festival, SF Transistor Radio Theatre, and the web series *Exit Stage Left*. Don't believe Scott Solomon; he owns many many crystals that he polishes daily.

John Mannion (Lenny Ganz), recently emerged from a 20-year off-stage hiatus. Since resurfacing, he's been busy — Hillbarn (Gypsy), Tabard (The Odd Couple), Foothill (Drood, Roe, Diary of Anne Frank), Custom Made / Z Space (Shoshana in December), Palo Alto Players (All Together Now), and Sunnyvale (Big Fish). Decades ago, John was a musical theater director (Stanford), improv/sketch performer (Mumblypeg, ComedySportz), and rock musician/vocalist. An advertising executive by day, John regularly performs in worldwide Zoom rooms. Huge thanks to his talented wife and daughters, mother, in-laws, coworkers, Studio A.C.T., and Coastal Rep for their encouragement. Next up, The Producers (Roger Debris) at Hillbarn.

Hilary Oglesby (Cassie Cooper) Hilary Kang Oglesby is an actor and model based in Los Angeles, CA, but so thrilled to be performing in her Coastal Rep debut back home in the Bay. Originally from Cupertino, Oglesby graduated from Occidental College in 2022 with a degree in Theater and Computer Science and a minor in Mathematics. Some of her favorite on-stage roles have

One of Hilary's favorite projects was a one woman show that she wrote, produced, and performed, which received the Jack Bell Award for Creative Achievement. Oglesby works as a web developer for a software company as well as a character performer for parties and events, usually Elsa from *Frozen*. She hopes that you enjoy the hilary-ous show!

Aaron Seymour (Officer Welch) Although only involved in community theater for a couple of years, Aaron has always been an actor and entertainer at heart. Through the pandemic he felt lucky to participate in Staged Readings and streamed performances, including the one-person show A Christmas Carol: The Radio Play for Pacifica Spindrift. He started 2022 with a big bang as Lloyd Dallas in Noises Off here at CRT, followed by La Cage Aux Folles (Francis) and A Nice Family Gathering (Jerry Myers), both at The Altarena in Alameda. Starting 2023 back at the CRT feels like the best omen of things to come.; and he couldn't do any of it without his wife, Marci.

Scott Solomon (*Glenn Cooper*) returns to the Coastal Rep stage after last appearing as Sidney Bruhl in 2021's production of *Deathtrap*. He has performed all over the Bay Area. Favorite theatre credits include Henry Higgins in *My Fair Lady* (Broadway by the Bay), Captain Von Trapp in *The Sound of Music* (Foothill Music Theatre), Lord Aster in *Peter and the Starcatcher* (Hillbarn Theatre), Gordon in *Dead Man's Cell Phone* (Los Altos Stage Company), Father in *Eurydice*, and Alan in *God of Carnage* (Palo Alto Players). Scott lives in Half Moon Bay with his husband, two Shiba Inus, and no crystals.

Jaap Tuinman (Ken Gorman) Jaap is delighted to return to CRT with gratitude and appreciation for Rumors' amazing cast, crew, and production team. Rumor has it Jaap's previous roles at CRT have included Col. Brandon in Sense & Sensibility (2017), Andrew Makepeace Ladd II in Love Letters (2021), and MC Freddie Fillmore (and a dozen other characters) in It's A Wonderful Life - A Live Radio Play (2015). A HMB resident, Jaap has also spent summers in Carter Park with HMB Shakespeare (Banquo in Macbeth, Caliban in The Tempest, Snug The Lion in Midsummer Night's Dream). Prior to landing coastside, Jaap spent time on various stages across Canada. Corlette Lotridge (*Costumer*) has created, designed and managed costuming for over 20 years. She has enjoyed costuming shows at Sea Crest School, Crystal Springs Uplands School, CRT Summer Drama Camp, and Coastal Rep. Kristen Pearson (*Lighting Designer*) Kristen absolutely loves comedies, and *Rumors* is truly one of her favorites. She has had such fun lighting this show and being able to get to know this hilarious cast. She has recently acted in *Spamalot* and *Christmas in Oz* at Coastal Repertory Theatre, while at the same time creating the lighting for *Christmas in Oz*. She has designed sound for Starting Arts, and most recently for *Murder on the Nile* at Coastal Rep. Her Lighting Design debut was her work on *Something Rotten* at Coastal Rep. 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
















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
