# DIRECTOR'S NOTES...

When I first saw *Bright Star* at the Curran Theatre in SF, I remember jumping to my feet during the bows and shouting out, "I want to direct this show!" It had everything I love in a musical — humor, suspense, poignant scenes, and great music with a new sound. So I pitched the show to the Artistic Committee at Coastal Rep, and I was chosen to direct it in 2020, the year when everything closed down for Covid.

Finally getting to direct *Bright Star* in 2023 is also a dream come true for me because I'm a huge fan of Steve Martin and have followed his career all my life. You see, "way back in the day," we both attended Garden Grove High School near Disneyland. In his memoir *Born Standing Up*, Steve Martin talks about how our wonderful high school theatre and his performing at Disneyland and Knott's Berry Farm were the beginning of his storied career. My life also changed because that high school theatre was critical in my decisions to major in drama in college and become a high school drama teacher. When I was a drama teacher in Newark, CA, I produced Steve Martin's first play - *Picasso at the Lapin Agile*. Now everything has come full circle for me.

I loved being on the stage as an actor when I was young – my last acting role was at CRT in the 2005 production of *The Laramie Project*. However, these days I prefer the technical side of theatre, for it's the process of putting on a play, the collaborative efforts from numerous talented designers and theatre artists that make the production of a live play so enjoyable for me.

This group of designers, performers, and stage mangers, have all created a feast for your eyes and ears, bringing to life the joy, the sadness, and the redemption that is in *Bright Star*. I owe a debt of gratitude to each and every person who is listed as Staff, Cast, and Crew — especially Susan Savich, Mary Stadler, Doug McCurdy, Michele Parry, Matt Mattei, Emily Simpson, Valerie Clear, Jared Alexander, Ginger Cutter, and my great friend Kathryn Murdock. I love working in the dark with talented, creative people and making things go "Bump in the Night," as my dear friend Shannon Quinn used to say.
